### **Key Findings:**

- Garden or landscaping (51%), storage and organisation (31%) and painting (28%) are the projects that Kiwis have on the list
- 42% of Kiwis plan to undertake some form of D.I.Y. over the Easter break
- 70% of those undertaking projects this Easter are doing so due to the extended break.
- 1 in 4 say it will take them an entire weekend to do the job they have planned, while 30% believe their jobs can be tackled within the day.
- 47% of Kiwis will prioritise relaxing at home this Easter
