#### **IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS**

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock and injury to persons, including the following:

#### FOR YOUR SAFETY

Read all instructions carefully, even if you are quite familiar with the appliance.

- To prevent fire or shock hazard, do not expose this appliance to rain or moisture.
- Dangerous high voltages are present inside this enclosure. To avoid electric shock, Do not open the cabinet. Refer servicing to qualified personnel only.
- This appliance is intended for indoor use only and not for commercial, industrial or outdoor use. Other use not recommended may cause fire, electric shock or injury.
- To protect against fire, electrical shock and injury to persons, do not immerse, plug or cord the unit in water or spray it with liquids.
- The apparatus shall not be exposed to dripping or splashing. Do not place the fan close to an open window. Rain splashing on the fan could cause an electric shock hazard.
- Ventilation should not be impeded by covering the ventilation openings. Slots and opening are provided for ventilation to ensure reliable operation of the product and to protect it from overheating.
- Place the fan on a stable level surface when operating to avoid overturning.
- Only connect to a suitably AC 220-240V~50Hz mains socket.
- Do not operate the fan in the presence of explosive and/ or flammable fumes. Do not place the fan or any parts near an open flame, cooking or other heating appliance. Never install the unit where it could be subject to mechanical vibration/shock or excessive dust.
- Do not operate the fan with a damaged cord or plug, after a malfunction or if it is dropped or damaged in any manner.


- Do not use fan near curtains, plants, window treatment, or where other objects can become caught in the blades. Do not let the power cord hang over the edge of a table or counter or let it touch any hot surfaces.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Do not leave the appliance running or operable in a place where young children or animals could have access to it without supervision.
- Turn the fan off and unplug it from the outlet when it is not in use, when moving fan from one location to another and before cleaning.
- To disconnect, grip the plug and pull it from the wall outlet. Never pull by the cord.
- Do not attempt to repair, disassemble or modify the appliance. There are no userserviceable parts inside.

#### WARNING:

- Avoid contact with moving parts. Do not insert fingers or allow foreign objects to enter the grille openings as this may cause damage to the appliance and/or injury to the user.
- Do not use the fan without fully assembled. The fan must operate standing upright.
- Do not operate without the fan grilles properly in place. Do not use the fan if grille becomes deformed, damaged or loosen to avoid injury to persons.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

## **OPERATING THE BOX FAN**

- 1. Remove the box fan and parts from its packaging and remove all packaging materials.
- 2. Remove cable tie and unravel the power cord before operation.
- 3. Place your fan on a level and dry surface keeping in mind the safety precautions outlined.
- 4. Plug the fan in to a suitable AC 220-240V~50Hz mains outlet.
- 5. This fan utilises a mechanical clock timer. This enables you to preset the fan to switch off automatically with a delay of up to 120 minutes. Turn the Timer knob clockwise to set the timer as you desire. When the set time has elapsed, the fan will turn off automatically. The fan can be switched off manually at any time by turning the Timer knob to OFF position. If you wish the fan to run continuously, turn the Timer knob anticlockwise to ON position to deactivate the timer function.
- Note: Do not force the Timer knob past the 120 Minutes on the dial.
- Rotate Speed knob to select the desired speed setting and use the fan. There are 4 settings – 0 (off), 1 (low), 2 (medium) and 3 (high).
- 7. The front grille of fan can be set to rotation by turning on the Louver Switch to MOVE position. Turn the Louver switch to STOP position to deactivate the grille rotation.

8. Turn the fan off and unplug it from the mains outlet after use.

CAUTION: The box fan can be used upright only. Stop operating the fan immediately when it is tipped over.

#### **CARE AND CLEANING**

- Always disconnect the fan from mains socket before cleaning.
- · Avoid contact with moving fan parts.
- Use only a soft damp cloth to clean the fan.
- DO NOT immerse the fan in water and never allow water to drip into the Motor Housing.
- Never spray the appliance with liquids or submerge it in water or other liquid.
- DO NOT use gasoline, paint thinner or other chemicals to clean the fan.
- Ensure that the fan is switched off from the mains outlet before removing the guard.
- Clean the fan blade and grilles with a soft damp cloth.
- Store the fan in its original box or cover the fan to protect it from dust in a dry place if it will not be used for a long period of time.
