# Before using this product, please read the following instructions carefully and keep for future reference.

### **1. WARNING**

- This heated airer should be installed and placed away from the shower, bath, or any area which could cause water damage. 1.1
- 1.2 Unplug appliance when not in use
- Do not use if airer, power cord or plug is damaged. Please contact Visy Retail Services for any product issues. 1.3
- Children should not play with the heated airer; this is not a toy. 1.4
- 1.5 Cleaning and user maintenance should not be carried out by children.
- 1.6 This heated airer is intended only for drying fabrics washed in water.
- Only use to dry washable fabrics. Not suitable for silk. 1.7
- Do not use to dry fabrics which become marked or damaged by direct heat contact. 1.8
- 1.9 To conserve energy and use the heated airer safely, wring out clothes prior to placing them on the hanging rails.
- 1.10 The heated airer should only be connected to a power source compatible with the voltage stated.
- Do not use the heated airer if the heating pipes or any other part are damaged. 1.11
- 1.12 This heated airer comes equipped with a 3-pin plug.
- 1.13 Not intended for use with an extension cord. Plug the power cord directly into an appropriate wall power outlet.
- 1.14 Always fold the wings out before switching the airer on.
- 1.15 Not suitable for drying quilts, jackets and larger garments.

## 2. COMPONENTS & FUNCTIONS



ltem	Part Description	Function
1	Power Cord	3-pin plug to connect directly to your wall power outlet
2	Control Panel	Turn the heated airer on and off, adjust temperature and set timer
3	Support Legs	Folding base for the heated airer
4	Heating Region	Hanging rails used to dry clothes

#### **3. INSTRUCTIONS**

- 3.1 Open the support legs, unfold the heating region and position on a stable floor.
- 3.2 Connect the power cord directly to the wall power outlet and turn on the power button (U) on the control panel.
- 3.3 Press the temperature control button () to adjust the temperature between 45° and 70°C. The heated airer will reach the desired temperature after being on for approximately 5 minutes.
- 3.4 Press the power button (U) to set the timer between 1 and 24 hours.
- 3.5 Hang clothes on the hanging rails.
- 3.6 Once finished, turn the appliance off by holding the power button (U) then unplug from wall power outlet. Allow the heated airer to cool before folding and storing away.

#### 4. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- 4.1 Before cleaning, the heated airer must be disconnected from the power source and the heating region allowed to cool down completely.
- 4.2 Do not immerse any part of the heated airer in water.
- 4.3 Wipe the rack down with a damp cloth then use a soft cloth to dry. Do not use metal balls or scourers to clean the hanging rails.
- 4.4 Ensure the power cord and plug are completely dry before using again.
