



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Flexible Water Connector

Thank you for purchasing one of our quality Kinetic products.

IMPORTANT!

- Plumbing products must be installed by a licensed plumber in accordance with AS/NZS 3500 and local or state regulations.
- BEFORE installing flexible hose, read these instructions carefully to ensure proper assemble, installation and usage.
- BEFORE using flexible hose, ensure that all components are installed securely.
- **DO NOT** attempt to use flexible hose if any components are damaged or missing. DO NOT use alternative substitute parts. Substitute parts will not be covered by product warranty.

INSTALLATION:

- 1. Turn off water supply and remove old hose.
- 2. Clean all connecting threads.
- 3. Install conncector. See notes below.
- 4. Turn water on and inspect for leaks.

NOTES:

- a. Suitable for hot and cold water
- b. Do not over tighten nuts. Loose end nut should be tightened between 5-8 N.M
- c. 1/2" FL x 1/2" FL BSP Class 2 hose
- d. Hose has a 30mm Minimum bend radius. Do not stretch, twist, kink or expose to naked flames or corrosive agents
- e. Operating specifications:

Working temperature: min 2°C - max 50°C Pressure limits: min 150kPa - max 500kPa

g. Flexible hose must be used in an accessible location and not buried or submerged or not in direct uv/sunlight application. Not suitable for use inside walls, ceiling, underground etc
