Bunnings Group incorporates retail operations under the Bunnings Warehouse, Bunnings, Bunnings Trade, Beaumont Tiles and Tool Kit Depot brands. Bunnings takes a risk-based approach to the ethical procurement of goods and services based on the United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights (UNGPs), 'Protect, Respect and Remedy' framework. It is important to note, the supply chain map represents a sample of Bunnings' international supply chain of directly imported products and does not reflect Bunnings' total supply chain.

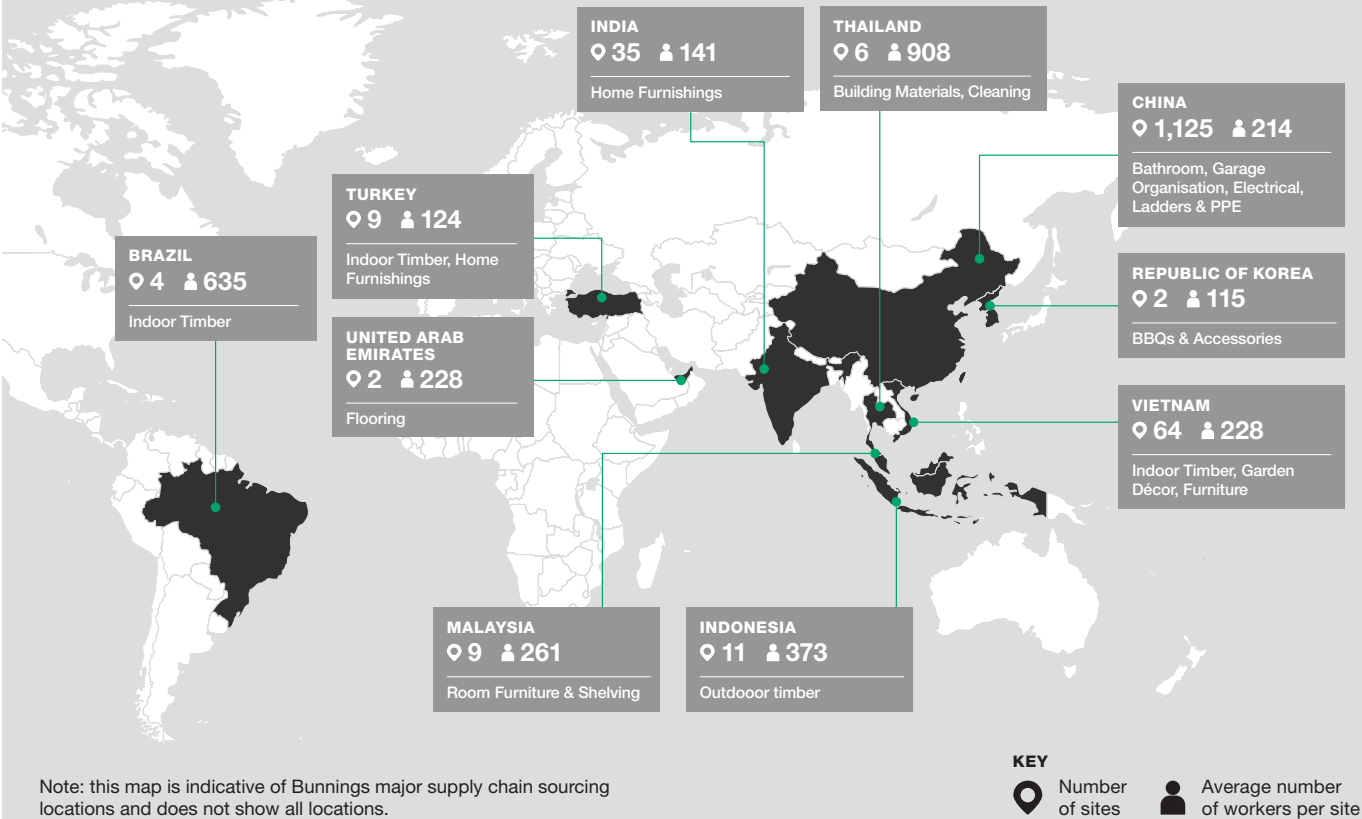
During the 2024 financial year, Bunnings conducted 1,170 pre-qualification risk assessments of direct suppliers and indirect manufacturers and completed more than 590 independent third-party audits throughout the supply chain. In response to these activities, Bunnings supported over 300 manufacturing sites to remediate more than 1,840 identified non-conformances, which improved working conditions for more than 85,100 workers in 20 countries.

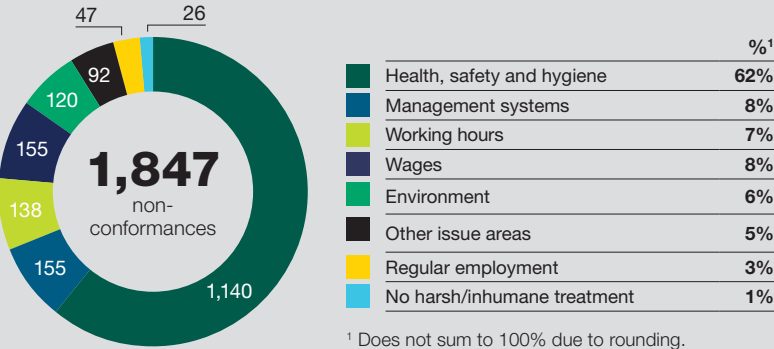
