## **Features & Benefits**

This product is specifically engineered to remain somewhat pliable following application, allowing the product to eliminate small voids and crevices during the compaction process.

#### **Applications**

- Pot Holes
- Driveways
- General repairs
- Footpaths

#### Coverage

 $3 \times 20 \text{kg bags (60kg)} = 1 \text{m}^2 \text{ with a depth of 23mm.}$ 

#### Curing

Dingo Bitumen hardens slowly as the bonding agent dries out. This progresses over several weeks depending upon application and weather conditions. During this period scuffing should be avoided.

Allow up to 6 months before applying driveway sealers or coatings to the repaired area.

#### **Storage**

It is recommended to use the entire contents of the bag once opened.

#### **Packaging**

Dingo Bitumen mix is packaged in handy 10kg plastic bags and 20kg plastic bags.



#### **Usage**

- 1. The area where you intend to use the product must be dry.
- 2. Remove any weeds and plant material.
- 3. Base must be thoroughly compacted. Crushed stone is recommended.
- 4. Apply material evenly, do not exceed 30mm in one application.
- 5. Leave for a few minutes and then compact using a roller, plate compactor or hand tamper.

## **Handy Hints**

- A 30mm layer should compact to approx. 25mm.
- For thicknesses greater than 50mm Dingo Bitumen is not recommended.
- Place at ambient temperature then no reheating is required.
- If the bag is firm to touch, leave in a warm place for 30 minutes.
- A light covering of sand is recommended to allow usage straight away.
