Dianella tasmanica 'TR20' 

Tasred has proven to be a very tough, adaptable and beautiful plant.

It has performed well in many different conditions in Perth, South Australia, Victoria, Tasmania, ACT and in NSW. In more hot humid regions like the NSW's North Coast and Queensland, where *Dianella tasmanica* usually struggles, it has done remarkably well in heavily shaded to slightly shaded conditions. It seems to cope with the extreme heat better than the common form.



For a reliable *Dianella tasmanica* that often has a beautiful red base and in colder climates frequently even changes its foliage colour from green, to green with reddish tinges, choose Tasred.

Its density and tidier appearance; its ability to cope with full sun or heavy shade; its excellent soil strengthening statistics; and its beautiful wider leaves make it a popular choice. DESCRIPTION	Ornamental flax lily with contrasting colour foliage
HEIGHT & WIDTH	40cm x 40cm
POSITION	Suited to full sun and moderate shade
CARE	Fertilise once in spring, trim older leaves as required
USES	Mass planting. Low water requirement gardens
SOIL TYPE	Sandy, sandy loam and clay soils
