



Hemerocallis 'Cranberry Baby'



 Height: 40cm - Spread 50cm
Full Sun to Part Shade



FEATURES:

- Prolific, repeating display of deep crimson flowers through summer and autumn.
- Compact variety with neat, mounding habit.
- Very tolerant of dry conditions.
- Attractive weeping foliage is evergreen.
- Easy to grow and exceptionally hardy.
- Ideal for water wise gardens.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Fast results for new gardens.
- Mass plant as low maintenance ground cover.
- Lengthy colour for mixed borders.
- Great in containers.
- Coastal zones and pool side landscaping.
- Cottage or wild flower style gardens
- Informal edging for paths, drives or garden beds.

CULTURAL CARE

- Low water requirements once established.
- Prefers a rich but well draining soil.
- No pruning required although removing spent flower stems encourages further displays.
- Feed in spring with slow release fertiliser.
- Frost hardy once established.

Despite having 'lily' in its common name, the daylily is not a member of the Lily family. Rather, the name refers to the large, colourful blooms lasting only for one day. Though this means that they are not ideal as a cut flower - the succession of blooms in the garden gives an outstanding, lengthy display season. Performance is unsurpassed with these hardy perennials which easily tolerate both dry and cold conditions making them very garden worthy!
