



1. ACCEPTABLE - Stock outside the edge of the pallet wrapped and strapped, wrap covering all stock



2. ACCEPTABLE – Unbalanced stock outside the edge of the pallet wrapped and strapped, wrap covering all stock



3. ACCEPTABLE – Long product balanced with no risk of fall – no wrapping and 3 straps



4. UNACCEPTABLE – a poor quality pallet strapped to a standard pallet



5. ACCEPTABLE– Multiple items and balanced – wrap only



6. UNACCEPTABLE - Stock unbalanced, wrap not covering all stock or all corners of the pallet

7. UNACCEPTABLE - Wrap not covering four corners of the pallet

8. UNACCEPTABLE - Wrap deteriorated as a result of weather exposure

9. ACCEPTABLE – Non standard pallets (skids) are unable to be locked into racking but if they are stable with no risk of collapse can be strapped to another standard pallet.

10. UNACCEPTABLE - Multiple products on a pallet over 1.8m and stored in racking

11. ACCEPTABLE - Single item products over 1.8 m can be placed in racking – they require strapping only

12. UNACCEPTABLE - Pallets cannot be placed on beams with 'No pallet' stickers.
