Bremick collated screws are specifically designed for all collated tools on the market; no matter the brand.

Collated Range

Each box has **1,000 screws**, which is made up of 20 strips with 50 screws per strip. The collated screw strips are held together through a soft malleable plastic, which makes it easier to feed into the collated gun & prevents the strip from jamming.

Typically, plasterboard screws are **6G in diameter**, ranging in lengths of **25mm**, **32mm or 41mm**. Designed for a variety of board thicknesses to be used in different applications.

Plasterboard sheeting used in domestic applications are generally 10mm thick with the **25mm collated screw** as the most popular size.

Packaging & Labels

The collated labels are designed for easy selection, providing all the traditional information including **size**, **quantity & thread type**.

Thread type is an important element of the screw, which is differentiated through colour – green signifies fine thread whilst yellow signifies course thread.

Stickers can be found in two locations per box; front and side.

COARSE FOR FIXING PLASTERBOARD TO TIMBER

All the screws have a bugle head design with a needle point drill tip and phillips drive, specifically designed for the plasterboard applications.

Available sizes:

6 x 25mm Coarse thread zinc yellow
6 x 32mm Coarse thread zinc yellow
6 x 41mm Coarse thread zinc yellow

HOW TO FIX PLASTERBOARD TO ANY MATERIAL

- STEP 1 Set collated screw gun to match the length of screw selected
- **STEP 2** Feed the strip into the collated gun, ensuring it slides between the guides
- **STEP 3** Click the collated strip into position
- **STEP 4** Adjust the guide on the tool to ensure the screws finish just below the surface without ripping the paper
- **STEP 5** Try the screws in a off cut to make sure the depth is correct

FINE FOR FIXING PLASTERBOARD TO THIN METAL

Bremick's fine thread collated screws have a unique **"Twin Start Thread"** which means faster installation every time.

Available sizes:

6 x 25mm Fine thread zinc yellow
6 x 32mm Fine thread zinc yellow
6 x 41mm Fine thread zinc yellow
