Please note: When moving shelving unit lift using the bottom leg uprights.

For evenly spaced shelves (from bottom shelf): 12 Free Keyholes, 11 Free Keyholes, 12 Free Keyholes, 11 Free Keyholes.

Anchor this product to a wall or other suitable surface with the provided "Tip over prevention kit". •Check anchors regularly











Add Rubber Feet (Part F) to bottom of 4 Angle Posts (Part D). Note upright position. Slot Long Beams (Part A) to the bottom of the Angle Posts (Part D) as shown into keyholes.

NOTE: Flat edges face outwards.




Fasten Short Beams (Part B) to the opposing keyhole of the attached Long Beam (Part A) to form a frame. Slot Brace (Part C) into position through the holes provided on the Long Beam (Part A).



Join the upper Angle Posts (Part D) to the lower Angle Posts (Part D) with the Connector (Part E).

NOTE: The legs are designed to sit directly on top of each other - don't overlap them.

Step 4




Place MDF Shelving on bottom shelf to minimise buckling. Fix Short Beam (Part B) and Long Beams (Part A) where top rivet sits on the upper Angle Posts and the bottom rivets sits on the lower Angle Post. Assemble frame at the very top allowing room for Shelving to sit flush against Angle Post.

Step 5



Apply remaining Beams as above to desired height. Ensure that Braces (Part C) are fixed to all shelves

Step 6



Place the MDF boards on shelves, ensure they are sitting flush against the edge of the shelf brackets.






TIP OVER PREVENTION KIT:
