



Cleaning & Maintenance of Azzurra Products

TAPWARE

Chrome and Gold plated finishes should be cleaned with warm soapy water and a soft cloth or sponge, rinsed and dried immediately then buffed with a dry soft cloth.

Under no circumstances must any detergents containing ammonia, hydrochloric acid or abrasives including cream cleansers be used.

The aerator, located at the water outlet, should be checked and cleaned regularly.

Multi jet showers with anti limestone nozzles

The anti-limestone nozzles are easily cleanable with a simple wipe of the hand. If any traces of limestone are left in the central holes of the shower, they may be eliminated by soaking the cartridge in a solution of water and vinegar.

MAINTENANCE - Should service be required on your mixer this must be done by a licenced plumber.

VITREOUS CHINA PRODUCTS

Vitreous china products can be maintained by wiping with a cloth or sponge and warm soapy water. Toilets bowls may be cleaned using cleaning products, but care should be taken using hanging bowl cleaners. Do not insert cleaning products into the cistern tank.

TOILET SEATS

Toilet seats should only be cleaned using a cloth or sponge and warm soapy water. Under no circumstances must any harsh disinfectants, detergents containing ammonia, hydrochloric acid or abrasives including cream cleansers be used.

ACCESSORIES

Chrome and Gold plated finishes should be cleaned with warm soapy water and a soft cloth or sponge, rinsed and dried immediately then buffed with a dry soft cloth.

Under no circumstances must any detergents containing hydrochloric acid, ammonia or abrasives including cream cleansers be used.

VANITY UNITS

Vanity Tops can be cleaned with a mild cream cleanser of an approved nature if necessary, but generally warm soapy water and a soft cloth or sponge is sufficient. When using cream cleansers care should be taken not to use them on the chrome or gold surfaces of tapware or wastes and plugs.
