
USAGE INFORMATION

The Masport Hook Tool Set is designed and made in Australia from durable materials, that with proper use and care should last a considerable amount of time. To assist in the longevity of the tool set, some usage notes are provided below:


The broom has bristles made from a natural fibre that are resistant to heat, however, they are not flame resistant and any prolonged contact with an open flame or glowing hot coals should be avoided.



The shovel has been designed specifically for use with a wood fire, as such it is not advised to use the shovel for any other purposes such as digging or shoveling soil.



The fire poker is shaped to provide optimal control of your fire. The two hooked ends can be used to pull and push logs around the fire, while the flat side can be used to rake the coals.





WARRANTY

The benefits provided to you under the following warranty are in addition to any other rights and remedies available to you under the law.

1. Warranty

If during the first year from the date of purchase (Warranty Period), there is a defect in the fire tool set or storage unit (Product(s)), due to improper workmanship or material, Glen Dimplex will replace or repair the product without charge. Any replacement product is warranted only for the time remaining on the original Warranty Period or the Parts Warranty Period as relevant.

2. Registration

You must register to receive the benefit of this warranty by completing the warranty registration on our website (https://www.masportheating.com.au/en-au/support/warranty) within 30 days of purchase of your product.

3. Exclusions

Glen Dimplex is not obliged to replace or repair the Product under clause 1 if:

(a) it has been improperly stored, installed, assembled, used, operated or repaired, or damaged, abused, tampered with, altered (without our written approval), or not maintained in strict accordance with our installation and operating instructions; or

(b) it has been installed in an outdoor setting.

4. Limit of Liability

The warranty provided under this warranty is limited to replacement or repair of the Product only, at our option. To the extent permitted by law, Glen Dimplex excludes liability for consequential loss or any other loss or damage caused to property or persons arising from any cause whatsoever, and damage arising from normal wear and tear.

5. Claiming under the Warranty

In order to claim under this warranty you must, within the Warranty Period or the Parts Warranty Period (as relevant), contact Glen Dimplex, providing the original proof of purchase and the details below:

You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.
