The best flowering Dianella revoluta available.

It is a medium sized Dianella revoluta which will spread slightly over time, however for this reason, it is good for situations that need erosion control. Its large rhizomes help stabilise the soil and strengthens it 135%.

DESCRIPTION	Medium sized Dianella revoluta
HEIGHT & WIDTH	50cm x 50cm
POSITION	Full sun to part shade
CARE	Fertilise once a year with slow release fertiliser
USES	Mass plantings, foliage or grassy gardens
SOIL TYPE	Sandy, sandy loam clay

From a distance, Revelation has blue tones to the foliage. On closer inspection, one side of the leaf is blue and the other is green. This gives it a unique colour. Revelation puts on a show with an abundance of beautiful blue flowers from mid Spring through to early Summer followed by beautiful berries. Once established, it can survive on natural rainfall in many areas of Australia. Wyeena is better suited to planting in frost affected areas compared to other variegated Dianella types. Wyeena has striking foliage to brighten up any dull area in the garden.

CARE	Plant in well mulched garden. Remove older leaves as required
USES	Ideal as foliage plant, mass plantings, feature pot displays
SOIL TYPE	Heavy clay to free draining soils

shaded positions. Performs well in heavy clay to free draining soils. Best suited to non humid environments such as VIC, SA, ACT, WA, TAS and worth a try in Sydney. Plant Wyeena in a well mulched garden. Occasionally fertilise with a slow release fertiliser. Remove older leaves as necessary and water as required to keep plant healthy. Wyeena is relatively drought tolerant. Leaves can be trimmed in spring if leaf burn occurs.
