



Installation


Select a suitable installation location

*Note: Before beginning installation, please thoroughly read the Retracting Clothesline manual to determine a suitable location and installation height requirements.

Install the Ground Socket


WARNING: Do not push the Ground Socket into setting concrete. It's important to follow the instructions and pour wet concrete around the Ground Socket.

- 1.1 Mark out the desired position for the socket, in line with the Retracting Clothesline Cabinet. Refer to your Retracting Clothesline Manual for more information about site selection and installation details
- 1.2 Dig a hole 200mm diameter by approximately 800mm deep. Place approximately 200mm of coarse gravel into the hole. This ensures water can drain from the Ground Socket. (Figure 1)


- 1.3 Insert the Post into the Ground Socket and place into the hole.
- 1.4 Adjust the Post and Ground Socket until the flange of the Ground Socket sits around 6-12mm above the ground (Figure 2). Ensure there is approximately 30mm of the Ground Socket buried into the gravel.



1.5 Prepare the concrete mix. Concrete should be damp enough to hold together when squeezed in your hand.

WARNING: Do not push the Ground Socket into setting concrete. Ensure concrete doesn't cover the Locking Collar.

- **1.6** Support the Post and Ground Socket and concrete into position. Settle the concrete by pushing a thin stick into the mix several times.
- 1.7 Use a spirit level to check that the assembly is level. Slope the top surface of the concrete away from the post to provide drainage. (Figure 3).
- 1.8 Allow 48 hours for the concrete to set before use. Do not remove the post until the concrete has set.
