Roller Blind Installation Instructions





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Step 4. Installation





First insert ball chain mechanism of the first blind onto the matching bracket, then insert endplug with pin onto the opposite bracket.





Insert ball chain mechanism of the second blind onto the matching bracket, then insert endplug with pin onto the opposite bracket.

Adjusting the chain's length (optional)

The chain can be shortened using the chain connector provided. In order to shorten the chain, please roll the blind all the way up. Please cut the front of the chain only approximately 30mm below the winding mechanism. Attach the chain connector.

Any expense in claiming the warranty will be paid by the customer. The warranty covers manufacturer defects in materials, workmanship and finish under normal use. The warranty does not cover general wear & tear and commercial applications. Install both tension devices using screws provided in the pack. Adjust position so that the chain can pass through device freely.

Tension devices included in the package must be installed in order to avoid creating a possible strangulation hazard for children!

Care and Maintenance:

Surface dust may be removed with gentle brush, feather duster, clean dry cloth. If the blinds are especially dirty, use the brush attachment on the vacuum to gently brush over the surface.

A solution of lukewarm water and mild detergent may be used to spot clean stains and smudges. Always spot test in inconspicuous area before cleaning. Do not wash. Do not dry clean. Do not iron.

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WARNING:

- 1. To avoid creating a possible strangulation hazard for children, the corded internal window covering must be installed in such a way that a loose cord cannot form a loop 220mm or longer at a height of less than 1600mm above floor level.
- 2. A cord guide may be installed lower than 1600mm above floor level if the cord is sufficiently secured or tensioned to prevent a loop 220mm or longer from being formed.
- 3. If a cord guide is installed lower than 1600mm above floor level it must be designed to prevent a child from being able to remove the cord.
- 4. If a cleat is used to secure the cord it must be at least 1600mm above floor level because a child is capable of unwinding a cord from a cleat.
