



When assembling or installing this product wear protective gloves and eyewear.




PLEASE NOTE: Tip-over prevention bracket x8 included (refer to last step for installation).




Attach the top frame to the bottom frame by sliding the connector into each other. Align the cross-bracing to the 3 holes on the back of the frame and fix with the provided screws.

Please note: Adjustable feet on the frame should be positioned at the bottom.




Repeat step 1 for the remaining top and bottom frames.

Please note: Adjustable feet on the frame should be positioned at the bottom.



Attach 4x shelf supports to your desired height and place the first shelf in position, then repeat for all remaining shelves.

Please note: Ensure each shelf sits firmly on the shelf supports.



Attach the 3x clothes rails and 18x drawer runners to your desired height by pressing into the slots on the frame and slide the baskets onto the runners.

Please note: Wheels on the runners should be facing the front of the wardrobe.



Please note: For stability and safety, fix the unit to a wall with the provided brackets. Place the brackets over the rear frame legs at the top and bottom, then attach to your wall. Necessary fixings for these brackets can be found at your local hardware store.
