SECTION 1 - CHAIR ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Step 1

Place **Component A** flat on the ground and insert **Component C** and **Component E** into the relevant slots.




Step 2

Place Component D into the gap between Component C and Component E.




Step 3

Slot Component B onto the relevant inserts of Component C and Component E.



Step 4


Once all the components are slotted together, affix Component B to Component C and Component E using 3 x S1 Screws and the Allen Key provided.



SECTION 1 - CHAIR ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Step 5

Carefully rotate the chair keeping all components together and repeat **Step 4** on the other side.




Step 6

Make sure **Component D** is still in place correctly. Holding **Component D** firmly in place, affix it to the chair frame using the **4 x S2 Screws** and a **Phillips Head**



Step 7

Rotate the chair to its upright position and **tighten all screws**.

SECTION 2 - BENCH ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Step 1

Place **Component A** flat on the ground and insert **Component C** into the the relevant slots.




Step 2

Insert Component D into relevant slots on Component C and Component E.




Step 3

Insert Component E into the relevant slots of Component A and Component D.



Step 4


Slot Component B onto the relevant inserts of Component C and Component E.



SECTION 2 - BENCH ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Step 5

Once all the components are slotted together, affix Component B to Component C and Component E using 3 x S1 Screws and the Allen Key provided.




Step 6

Carefully rotate the bench keeping all components together and repeat **Step 5** on the other side.




Step 7

Make sure Component D is still slotted into place correctly. Holding Component D firmly in place, affix it to the bench frame with using the 4 x S2 Screws and a Phillips Head Screwdriver.



Step 8

Rotate the bench to its upright position and tighten all screws.







SECTION 3 - TABLE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


Step 1

Place **Component A** upside down on the ground and place the table legs **(Component B)** into position.




Step 2

Holding the table legs (**Component B**) firmly in place, affix them to the table top using **4 x S3 Screws** and the **Allen Key** provided.



Step 3

Tighten all screws and rotate the table to its upright position.
