
Over the past couple of years in particular, our store teams have worked tirelessly to help customers to stay safe and productive in their homes and this is great recognition of all their efforts.


Who are we?

Sustainability

At Bunnings we are committed to reducing the environmental impact of our operations.

We are also committed to helping customers live more sustainably in the home and garden, and we are proud of the role we play in supporting local communities to make a positive difference through small but impactful actions. We recognise that our business plays an important role in reducing carbon emissions and addressing climate change. Bunnings is committed to sourcing 100 per cent renewable electricity by 2025 to help achieve our target of net zero Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2030.

We have a comprehensive roadmap in place to reduce our energy consumption and to transition towards using more renewable energy sources. To deliver on this, Bunnings has signed long-term renewable electricity power purchase agreements. Over 60 per cent of the entire Bunnings network is now powered by renewable electricity. In New Zealand, Bunnings' network is powered by 100 per cent renewable electricity.



To reduce the energy we consume, we aim to continually improve energy efficiency across our network. LED lighting is standard for all new Bunnings stores, reducing energy use by more than 30 per cent per store.

We also continue to grow our local generation of renewable power by installing solar PV systems across our network. We have over 100 solar PV systems on our stores across Australia, covering more than 195,000 square metres of roof space and each generating up to 30 per cent of a store's energy needs.

As the third largest industry in Australia in terms of employees and contribution to GDP, construction has staggeringly few female participants: 11 percent of the construction industry is female in management, support and administration roles. only two percent of the industry is women in trades and on the tools. Bunnings Trade is committed to providing meaningful support to help achieve better gender equality and foster a more inclusive and diverse construction industry. In 2023, Bunnings Trade celebrated the launch of a new \$100,000 initiative aimed at supporting women in trades early on in their careers. The Award recognised 10 women in a trade currently completing an apprenticeship or recently qualified within the last 12-months. Successful applicants and their employers were granted support packs worth over \$10,000, as well as on-going professional and wellbeing support from the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC).



TIACS

TIACS is a professional mental health counselling service for tradies, truckies, farmers and blue collar workers. Founded by Dan Allen and Ed Ross, co-owners and directors of social enterprise workwear company, TradeMutt, TIACS is seeking to remove the barriers that prevent hard-working Australians from accessing personal mental health counselling. In 2024, Bunnings Trade announced a three-year partnership with the free mental health counselling service, with 100% of proceeds from the sales of co-branded items being donated directly to TIACS.
