TO STA	ART A C	OLD ENGINE:
1		Turn the ignition switch to the "on" position.
2	12	Make sure the chain brake is in the "brake" position by pushing forward on the lever/hand guard.
3	(a)	Fully press and release the primer bulb at least 10 times.
4	0°4 0	Pull the choke lever all the way out to the "full-choke" position.
5		When the temperature is above 10°C, pull the starter grip until the engine attempts to start, but no more than 3 times. When the temperature is below 10°C, pull the starter grip until the engine attempts to start, but no more than 5 times.
6	(j)	Push the choke lever to the "half-choke" position.
7		Pull the starter grip until engine starts, but no more than 5 times. If the engine does not start, repeat steps 1 to 7.
8		Depress the trigger release and squeeze the throttle trigger, then release the throttle trigger to return the engine to idle.
9	(15-387)	Allow the product to run idle for 15 - 30 seconds.
10	<u>~</u>	Before accelerating the engine or cutting wood, make sure the chain brake is in the "run" position by pulling back on the brake lever/hand guard.
TO STA	ART A W	ARM ENGINE:
0		Turn the ignition switch to the "on" position.
2	12	Make sure the chain brake is in the "brake" position by pushing forward on the lever/hand guard.
3	0 ,	Pull the choke lever all the way out to the "full-choke" position.
4	(j)	Push choke lever to the "half-choke" position.
6	2	Pull starter grip until engine runs, but no more than 5 times. If engine does not start after 5 pulls, use cold engine starting procedure.
6		Depress the trigger release and squeeze the throttle trigger, then release the throttle trigger to return the engine to idle.
0	42	Before accelerating the engine or cutting wood, make sure the chain brake is in the "run" position by pulling back on the brake lever/hand guard.
TO STOP THE PRODUCT:
