- Continued suspension of sausage sizzles, family events, in-store cafes and children's activities
- Gloves and hand sanitiser for team members
- Contact tracing

'We're so happy to be welcoming customers back into our stores in Greater Auckland. We're continuing to adapt how we operate to keep everyone safe and ensure customers can access the products they need safely during Level 2.
