Judging Process	<p>Submissions will be given a score out of 50 and ranked according to score, highest to lowest.</p> <p>Submissions will be scored on: Impact (0-10 points), Initiative (0-10 points), Community Benefit (0-10 points), Alignment with Category (0-10 points), and Story Strength (0-10 points).</p>

Community Pride Legend Someone who creates a welcoming environment and fosters a strong sense of local pride and social connection.2. Community Resilience Legend Someone who has helped their community overcome adversity and bounce back.3. Community Inclusion Legend Someone who is a champion for diversity, accessibility and inclusion and makes people feel they belong.4. Community Wellbeing Legend Someone who champions wellbeing and safety to help their community thrive.5. Overall winner – Bunnings Community Legend for 2026 A standout community legend (submitted for any of the 4 key categories) who is a best-in-class example of an everyday Australian who has made a legendary

<p>How many winners will there be and how will they be chosen?</p>	<p>Across 10 weeks (February 2026 – April 2026), 50 local Community Legends will be announced by Bunnings, or 5 per week. These local Community Legends will be scored in line with the Judging Process and contacted to determine further information.</p> <p>Out of the local winners, a panel (to be determined) will vote for the five overall winners – one per category and an overall Bunnings Community Legend of 2026. This judging process will take place during May 2026.</p> <p>The five overall winners will need to be available in June (3rd of 4th) to attend the Bunnings Conference (hosted in Melbourne), where the National Community Awards ceremony will take place.
