





Who are we?

We recognise that our business plays an important role in reducing carbon emissions and addressing climate change. Bunnings is committed to sourcing 100 per cent renewable electricity by 2025 to help achieve our target of net zero Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 2030.

We have a comprehensive roadmap in place to reduce our energy consumption and to transition towards using more renewable energy sources. To deliver on this, Bunnings has signed long-term renewable electricity power purchase agreements. Over 60 per cent of the entire Bunnings network is now powered by renewable electricity. In New Zealand, Bunnings' network is powered by 100 per cent renewable electricity.



To reduce the energy we consume, we aim to continually improve energy efficiency across our network. LED lighting is standard for all new Bunnings stores, reducing energy use by more than 30 per cent per store.

We also continue to grow our local generation of renewable power by installing solar PV systems across our network. We have over 100 solar PV systems on our stores across Australia, covering more than 195,000 square metres of roof space and each generating up to 30 per cent of a store's energy needs.

Women in Apprenticeships Awards

As the third largest industry in Australia in terms of employees and contribution to GDP, construction has staggeringly few female participants: 11 percent of the construction industry is female in management, support and administration roles. only two percent of the industry is women in trades and on the tools. Bunnings Trade is committed to providing meaningful support to help achieve better gender equality and foster a more inclusive and diverse construction industry. In 2023, Bunnings Trade celebrated the launch of a new \$100,000 initiative aimed at supporting women in trades early on in their careers. The Award recognised 10 women in a trade currently completing an apprenticeship or recently qualified within the last 12-months. Successful applicants and their employers were granted support packs worth over \$10,000, as well as on-going professional and wellbeing support from the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC).



Mates in Construction

Established in 2008, MATES is a not-for-profit organisation that's dedicated to improving mental health support and reducing suicide rates among Australia's building and construction industry. Bunnings Trade is proud to be partnering with MATES to further support the important work they do to facilitate suicide prevention training at construction sites across Australia. This campaign is based on the simple but powerful premise that suicide prevention is everyone's business, and that the entire industry needs to play a part in improving mental health support for construction workers.
