Eligibility	1.1 The Coaching Legends promotion is open to volunteer coaches who are actively coaching within a recognised community sports club in Aotearoa New Zealand at the time of entry. 1.2 To be eligible, entrants or nominees must: • be aged 18 years or over at the time of entry; and • have successfully completed a police vet (or equivalent background check) within a three-year window, being the 2023-2026 calendar years (to be verified via confirmation from your associated club) and • be coaching on an unpaid, voluntary basis. 1.3 For the purposes of this promotion, a <i>volunteer coach</i> is defined as an individual who: • coaches on an unpaid basis, receiving no salary, wage, retainer or contractual payment for their coaching role; and • coaches within a not-for-profit, community-based sports club that is open to the public and primarily focused on grassroots or community participation. 1.4 The following individuals are not eligible to enter or be nominated for the promotion: • paid or professional coaches, including those receiving regular or contractual remuneration; • volunteer or paid coaches operating within schools, kura, tertiary institutions or other educational organisations; • coaches affiliated primarily with commercial, private, corporate or elite performance programmes; • individuals coaching as part of non-sporting organisations, including but not limited to youth services, charities or workplace programmes, where sport is not the organisation's primary purpose. • directors, officers, management, employees and contractors (and their immediate families) of: ○ the Promoter; and ○ the agencies, companies or participating premises associated with this promotion.
