



This lock is factory preset for 45mm (1-3/4") Doors, if your door thickness is 45mm (1-34"), skip Step 2 and go to Step 3






2B Remove outside trim exposing castle nut and retainer plate.



CENTRE LINE




OPPOSE JOINT BLADE TO CATCH


OUTSIDE LEVER

2E Turn the key 90° clockwise in lever and push lever onto the lock body. Turn the key back to correct position to release. Test lever is fitted correctly.






3A Inset latch unit and fix it with two screws.




3B Place lock body into position. Make sure that latch prongs engage chassis in housing, and slide engages latch tail.



CATCH CAN NOT BE COVERED BY


3C Install inside spring cage. Note: Joint blade must face opposite to spring catch.















IF THE DOOR IS THICKER THAN 50MM, THE CATCH WILL BE COVERED BY INSIDE ROSE, DO NOT INSTALL INSIDE LEVER AND LOCK.

3D Fix inside rose and make sure inside rose and inside spring cage are tightened.



3E Slide lever onto spindle. Push lever completely into place. (Pull on lever to make sure that catch is fully engaged.)



- **4A** Door seals must be installed before the strike plate.
- 4B Close door until the latch-bolt rests in the door jamb.
- **4C** Mark centre of bolt on door jamb, this mark can be used to position strike plate.
- **4D** Mark and drill 25mm hole inside the jamb to a depth of 25mm on marked bolt centre position.
- **4E** Position the strike plate and mark around. Chisel recess until strike plate sits flush with door jamb face.
- 4F Fasten strike plate to door jamb with screws.
- **4G** Close door and check if the door rattles. If required, remove strike plate and bend anti-rattle tab to reduce rattle. Re-fit strike plate and re-check rattle.
