

Dual Roller Blind - Boston

Preparation and Fixing Instructions

Your pack should consist of the following components:

8 x Screws (Timber)

- 8 x Plugs (Masonry)
- 2 x Child Safety Device
- 2 x Brackets

STEP 1 - Select Your Mount & Measure Your Window (FIG.1)

- FACE MOUNT: This blind is installed outside the window frame
 - 1) With Architrave; take the external width measurements, including the architrave
 - 2) Without Architrave; take the width of the opening and add anextra 100mm
- RECESS MOUNT: This blind is installed inside the window frame; take 3 width measurements to determine if the window is square.
 If it's not, use the smallest measurement
- Once you have selected your mount, measure the length and width of your window to ensure the correct size blind has been selected for your installation type

STEP 2 - Side Chain

- Decide if you want the ball chain mechanism to operate from the left hand side or the right* and insert into the tube on the chosen side
- Insert the pin end into the opposite side (FIG.2)
- Universal Brackets allow for either face or side mount installtion. (FIG.3).

STEP 3 - Bracket Positioning

- Using the bracket as a template, measure and mark the mounting position including the fixing point locations
- Pre-drill pilot holes for screws to prevent any splitting of timber or architrave

STEP 4 - Fix Brackets

- Secure the brackets to the wall, ceiling, or architrave using screws provided
- Plugs may be required if the blind is being mounted into plaste board or masonry
- Ensure the brackets are installed in the right positions with the hex bracket matching the chain side and the pin matching the other bracket

STEP 5 - Install Blind

- Once the brackets are secured, lift blind into place by inserting the chain mechanism side into the hex bracket first (FIG. 4)
- For larger size blinds, a two-person lift may be required
- Gently slide the pin into the second bracket until it drops into place

Repeat for Second Roller


• STEP 6 - Child Safety Devices

Secure the child safety devices (FIG.5) on the wall with the supplied screws (refer to safety warning for more information)








